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REVITALIZATION OF A CHILDREN'S SPORTS CENTER



The project is dedicated to the reconstruction of an abandoned building on the premises of a school in Tomakivka, Dnipropetrovsk region. The main goal is to create a multifunctional space that provides comfortable conditions for sports activities, leisure, and community interaction, catering to both children and adults while considering modern social and environmental requirements.

The project proposes the preservation of existing architectural structures, the optimization of space zoning, and a strong focus on both aesthetic and functional renewal. A defining feature of the center is the creation of an inclusive swimming pool, designed to accommodate the needs of individuals with disabilities. This space is equipped with special ramps and an accessible layout to ensure maximum usability. The pool serves an important social function, promoting the involvement of all population groups in a healthy lifestyle.

Special attention has been given to creating areas for youth interaction, including relaxation zones, sports grounds, and spaces for cultural events. The project also incorporates ecological aspects by utilizing modern materials with a low carbon footprint, interactive technologies, and energy-efficient solutions.

The center will not only serve as a hub for sports and community development but also as an example of a contemporary approach to revitalizing abandoned facilities. The implementation of this project will contribute to strengthening social connections, promoting inclusivity, and ensuring a high level of architectural aesthetics in public spaces.



















































































WORKING IN THE MATERIAL











The project focuses on the revitalization of an abandoned building, transforming it into a modern and functional space for the community. The concept explores two possible scenarios: a cultural and artistic hub or a gastronomic venue. Both options aim to integrate the space into the urban environment while respecting its historical context and adapting it to contemporary needs.

Option 1: Cultural and Art Center

The first approach envisions the space as an exhibition center, where the labyrinth concept serves as a key architectural element. Multi-level surfaces, angular cuts, and a minimalist aesthetic create a dynamic environment, allowing multiple artists to showcase their work simultaneously. The use of a natural color palette—shades of green, brown, and white—along with wooden textures fosters a warm and inviting atmosphere while complementing industrial accents. The second level includes a lounge area, an art corner, and a lecture and event space, fostering cultural interaction and artistic expression.

Option 2: Public Dining Space

An alternative scenario transforms the space into a café or restaurant based on the "Farm to Table" concept, blending eco-friendly design with support for local producers. Natural materials, a pastel color palette, and thoughtful zoning contribute to a cozy and welcoming environment. Preserved architectural elements add authenticity and a vintage charm to the space. The first level serves as the main dining area, featuring ergonomic furniture arrangements and lush greenery. The second level includes a lounge area, a bar, and a performance stage, enabling various social and cultural events.

The project focuses on implementing one of these solutions to reactivate the building, integrating it into the urban landscape and enriching the local community's public life.
